Motion #3 – I move, to have Mary Blubaugh discuss the Attorney General's office to leave or revoke regulation by B. Moffitt 2nd J. McCart.

60-17-103(b): Motion # 4 – I move, that 60-17-103(b) read “ 5-10 years for accredited advance practice; (b) read 5

years for non-accredited programs. Mary Blubaugh was elected to work with AG office to re-word 68-17-103 by J. Walsh 2nd J. McCart.

Motion #5 – I move, to accept changes to subsection e the nurse administrator shall submit all changes to the board or board representative for approval by B. Moffitt 2nd A. Siple.

Anesthesia Assistants:

Briefly discussed issues with anesthesia assistants; It was noted that the didactic and clinical hours for the AA were an average rather a minimum. Anesthologist can supervise four AA's who can not work unless supervised. Missouri has passed legislation for the AA; will discuss further at next meeting.
