It was noted that language was left out that stated a motion was made, seconded and passed to approve Uniformed Services FNP and Perioperative CNS programs and to approve Graceland University FNP program. Unfinished Business

APRN Task Force Susan Bumsted and Alice Bell updated the Committee on the APRN Task Force. The APRN Task Force has no intentions on bringing a bill during the 2011 session. They are strategizing on bring a bill to the 2013 legislative session that would move them closer to the consensus model. The APRN Task Force needs to raise funds. Legislators need time to learn. The APRN Task Force is asking the Committee/Board to consider the following:

2. The Board/Committee to look at regulations that could be revised.

7. University of Oklahoma – Adult NP
8. Immaculata University, Psych CNS
9. University of Wisconsin – Eau Claire, FNP
10. Stonybrook – SUNY, Adult Health NP
11. South Dakota State University, FNP
12. Yale University, Peds NP
13. Missouri State University, FNP

It was moved to approve the out of state advanced practice programs as presented, with the exception of University of Wisconsin – Eau Claire, FNP, and Missouri State University (FNP). The approval of those two programs would remain pending approval of their curriculum. Stutzman/Pomatto. Motion #2 approved.
