Unfinished Business The APRN regulations were discussed concerning the changes in wording that the Attorney General’s office requested. It was the consensus of the committee to accept the changes and allow the regulations to continue to the legislative committee review.

New Business Licensee Paula Lea Cramer presented her Education Plan to be granted a CNS in Adult/Gerontology. After discussion, the committee voted to table the request by Ms. Cramer for approval of her proposed refresher course until she presents evidence of advance practice licensure in Kansas or other states, clinical transcripts of completion of advanced practice specialties, and NCC certification.
