The Jan/Feb issue of the Journal of Continuing Education in Nursing contains the results of the annual CE survey, including data on the CE requirements for advance practice nurses in all jurisdictions. She also provided an update on the NCSBN APRN Task force activities in identifying the criteria for review of certification programs and will report the results of the April APRN Task Force meeting and roundtable at the May meeting
