HB2187:

HB2187 was reviewed and discussed.

APRN HB2251:

Merilyn Douglass from the Kansas APRN task force spoke about
the language of HB2251. The bill was reviewed and discussed. The
Board is concerned with the “Transition to Practice” language. At
the December board meeting, the APRN Taskforce was asked to
include a 3 year transition to practice. The board continues to agree
with the concept of the bill.

It was moved that based on the current information that we have, the Board stand in opposition to the proposed HB2251. The rationale being that the language in the draft bill raises concerns over requirements and enforcement of requirements. Motion #2 Jacobs/Nioce. Roll call vote Adopted (7 Yea) (3 Nay).
