Call to order: The Education Committee meeting was called to order @ 8:35 A.M. by Diane Okeson, Chairperson in Room 106 of the Landon State Office Building.

Announcements:

1. Dr. Eileen Deges Curl is no longer with Fort Hays State University.
2. Dr. Wanda Bonnel, University of Kansas, will be filling her position on the Education Committee in advanced practice.
3. Washburn University to discontinue their Licensed Mental Health Technician Program.

Review of onsite packets

Add/revise agenda: Regulation review will follow annual report summary.  
It was moved we change the agenda to address regulation at the end so action items can be addressed first. Motion #1 Gilpin/Tidwell Adopted UYVV.

**Minutes:** The minutes of the May 2002 meeting were reviewed. It was moved the minutes be approved from the last meeting. Motion #2 Qamar/Hutchison Adopted UYVV.

Ed. Specialist Rept.: J. Pucci reported to the Board (see report)

**Consent Items:**

Petitions: Michael Collins petitioned the committee to retest the NCLEX-RN. After lengthy discussion the Committee requested staff inform the petitioner of the PN options for testing. It was moved Michael Collins be allowed to retest the NCLEX-RN. Motion #3 Tidwell/Gilpin Adopted UYVV.

Lyann Herriott petitioned to retest the NCLEX-PN. It was moved the board deny Lyann Herriott petition to retake the PN exam. Motion #4 Qamar/Welsh Adopted UYVV.

Philippine educated Vicente Gatan and Mary Ann Isales petitioned to retest the NCLEX-RN. These foreign applications were reviewed by staff and approved.

**Old Business:**

Nursing Scholarship: The board of nursing scholarship forms prepared by J. Pucci were reviewed. It was moved to approve the KSBN nursing scholarship application and disbursement to directors and the KSBN webpage. Motion #5 Gilpin/White Adopted UYVV.

**New Business**

Curriculum Req.: Seward County Community College represented by Steve Hecox Requested major curriculum changes. The general education course requirement changes are for information. Seward County Community College also requests to combine Nursing Seminar with Client Care Nursing in level II as a duplication of material occurs in these two courses. A 3 hours required elective course called Integration Seminar would be developed. The rationale for this change would be to focus on integrating nursing education experience and utilizing critical thinking skills in simulated client care situations and focus on applying principles that underlie the delivery of safe and effective care. This course would be required for students who achieve a NCLEX-RN probability success score of below 85% on the initial HESI comprehensive exit exam. The Integration seminar would be a required 3 credit hour elective course providing students to integrate nursing educational experiences, applying concepts, principles and critical thinking to solve problems and make decisions in simulated client care situations. This course which is designed to facilitate successful entry into nursing practice is required for students who achieve a NCLEX-RN probability success score of below 85% on the initial HESI comprehensive exit exam. Admission to the ADN program or a previously completed professional nursing program would be a prerequisite. It was moved we accept the major curriculum

changes request submitted by Seward County Community College. Motion #6 Walsh/White Adopted UYVV.

Southwestern College represented by Martha Butler requests to combine and renumber courses in the BSN program. (See Committee packet). The changes would reflect adjustments resulting from the change from 3 to 2 year sequencing of nursing curriculum content and experiences. She states this would allow for additional clinical experiences in acute care settings, maximizing the educational experience of students. Dr. Butler stated this proposal represents an increase of 1 credit hour overall in the nursing major. It was moved we accept Southwestern Colleges curriculum request with the request Martha Butler submit verification of preceptor % hours. Motion #7 Tidwell/Qamar Adopted UYVV.

Fort Scott Community College represented by JoAnn Thomas requests:

- 1) during spring 2003 to increase NUR1319 by one credit hour to 10 credits,
- 2) effective the Fall 2002 semester change the Health Assessment (NUR1213) from 3 credit hour course to a 1 credit hour course and,
- 3) implement Preceptorship Leadership Rotation into NUR2510 during the 4<sup>th</sup> semester to replace long Term Care Rotation. Chronic and Restorative Health Care Issues the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester during Fall 2002 the following changes would occur. Pain Management and Restorative Health Care issues during the Fall 2002 2<sup>nd</sup> semester would create the following changes.
  - A) Acute and Extended Health Care Issues would be moved to 4<sup>th</sup> semester NUR1319.
    - 1) Care of Patient with Disorders of the Lower Respiratory System
    - 2) Care of a Patient with Myocardial Infarction
    - 3) Care of Patient with Hematological Disorders
  - B) Care of the Patient with Disorders of the Eye would be moved from 4<sup>th</sup> semester NUR2510 to NUR 1319 effective 2002.
  - C) Emergency Disaster Planning and Bioterrorism component to NUR2510 would be added to the 4<sup>th</sup> semester. The theory component will come from Unit X, Diseases of the Eye, which will move to NUR 1319 second semester.
  - D) NUR1237-Principles of Health Promotion (1<sup>st</sup> semester)
    - 1) Pain Management unit expanded in the first semester.
    - 2) Death and Dying unit expanded in the first semester.
    - 3) Intraoperative unit to be moved to Second semester NUR1319 – Chronic and Restorative Health Care Issues, effective spring 2003. It was moved the major curriculum changes submitted by Fort Scott Community College be approved as follows:  
NURS 1319 increase credit hours to 10 credits

NURS 1213 decrease credit hours to one credit

NURS 2510 to replace Long Term Care Rotation and increase credit hours by one credit. Motion #8 Walsh/Tidwell Adopted UYVV. The committee requested Fort Scott Community College to submit total clinical hours and preceptor hours for information to the board.

Survey Visit Repts: Mid America Nazarene University: K. Gilpin and J. Pucci reported on the survey report of the Mid America Nazarene University. It was moved to approve Mid America Nazarene University survey visit with no requirements having received verification of pharmaceutical references in the library. Motion #9 Gilpin/White Adopted UYVV.

Larned State Hospital MHT Program: C. Maynard and J. Pucci reported on the survey visit at Larned State Hospital MHT Program. It was moved we accept survey visit of Larned State Hospital MHT program with no requirements. Motion #10 Tidwell/Qamar Adopted UYVV.

Wichita Area Technical College requested a change in the scheduled survey visit from Fall 2003 to February 18-20, 2003. This request is based on the fact that NLNAC will be on site in February and WATCPN would like to coordinate the visits. It was moved we accept Wichita Area Technical College requests for KSBN fall visit be rescheduled on Feb. 18-20 in coordination with their NLNAC visit. Motion #11 White/Gilpin Adopted UYVV.

Annual Reports: Annual report summaries were reviewed and discussed. It was moved to approve the 2002 annual report summary of schools of nursing with correction of no requirements for Pratt Community College and checking Seward Community College requirements. Motion #12 Gilpin/Qamar Adopted UYVV.

- K.A.R. 60-2-101: K.A.R. 60-2-101 Requirements for initial approval was reviewed. It was moved acceptance of 60-2-101 with changes as identified in packet. Motion #15 Tidwell/Gilpin Adopted UYVV.
- K.A.R. 60-2-102: K.A.R. 60-2-102 Reapproval requirements was reviewed. Suggested language, (b) If program is accredited by a national nursing accrediting agency, the survey visit may be in conjunction with the accrediting agency. A program without national accreditation will be surveyed every 5 years. New (C) Failure to meet education statutes and regulations. Old (D) to become new (B) and have new (E). It was moved we approve 60-2-102 with changes identified in committee. Motion #16 Tidwell/Qamar Adopted UYVV.
