Call to order: The Education Committee meeting was called to order @ 1:05 p.m. by K. Gilpin, in Room 106 of the Landon State Office Building.

Review onsite packet: 1. No action on the annual reports. Committee members to review and will discuss at September meeting.
2. KU Anesthesia program will be reviewed.
3. Add curr request tool major/minor curriculum guidelines
4. Add/rev Agenda:2003 Annual Report Summaries
5. Barton County Survey requests the PN Program approval site visit scheduled for the fall of 2004 be delayed until the spring of 2005.

It was moved the amended agenda be adopted. Motion #1 Bartel/Walsh adopted.

Minutes: The minutes of the May 13, 2003 meeting were reviewed. It was moved the May 03 minutes be approved as revised. Motion #2 Qamar/Hutchison Adopted.

Announcements: 1. Kathy Bode, Flint Hills Technical College is retiring and has resigned effective July 1, 2003.
2. NCSBN is calling for NCLEX item writers and reviewers.
3. Wichita Tech closing MHT program. No MHT schools are open in Kansas. Staff to work on phasing remaining MHTs into LPN.

Consent Items

Petitions: Adrienne Adams, Stephanie Houghton, Larisa Reida and Marlene Whittker, petitioned the committee to retake the NCLEX exam.

The petitions were reviewed by committee.

It was moved to deny petition of Adrienne Adams to retake the NCLEX-RN until she responds to the initial recommendations sent from KSBN. Motion #3 Bartel/Calhoun Adopted.

It was moved the petition for Stephanie Houghton be approved after receipt of PN-RN practice paper. Motion #4 Qamar/Calhoun Adopted.

It was moved we accept Larisa Dawn Reida's petition to retake the NCLEX RN. Motion #5 Bonnel/Hutchison Adopted.

It was moved approval of petition from Marlene Whittker to retake the NCLEX-PN. Motion #6 Bartel/Walsh Adopted

- Curr. Guidelines:** Major/Minor Curriculum Guidelines evaluation tool prepared by Jeanne Walsh was reviewed. The committee members will review and discuss at the September meeting. Staff to work on the tool next week.
- Refresher Course:** Washburn University represented by Carolyn Middendorf presented a 4 page document comparing the outline for refresher courses supplied by KSBN and the "long" content outline utilized by the Washburn School of Nursing to develop NU227: re entry into Nursing Practice. Committee likes the plan – suggested having information covered during orientation at St. Francis Hospital added to the outline to show content is covered. The committee will review the board refresher course outline and bring back to the September meeting. The committee will also review the requested copies of outlines from other schools teaching refresher courses for RN's and PN's. Newman, Dodge City, Hays and Wichita.

Old Business:

- Survey Visits:** The survey visit schedule for NLNAC and CCNE through Spring 2012 was included in the packet with the PN and MHT programs accredited by KSBN.
- Pass Rates:** Pass rates update and list of states that do not share pass rates are not yet available. Janette has had difficulty getting information from other states.

New Business:

- Orientation:** The date for Nurse Orientation was discussed and was scheduled for September 30th. Orientation for new directors will be in the morning and the directors meeting in the afternoon.
- Survey Schedule:** The Fall Survey Visit Schedule was reviewed. Barton County asked to change survey visit from fall 2004 to spring 2005 in conjunction with NLNAC visit. It was moved to grant request to move Barton CCC-PN

survey visit from fall 2004 to Spring 2005 in conjunction with NLNAC visit. Motion #7 Bartel/Bonnel Adopted.

Curriculum Requests:

Bethel College: Bethel College represented by Carole Moore, requested the nursing course hours be changed to be consistent with the way Bethel College recognizes classroom instruction for general education courses 15 clock hours = 1 credit didactic credit hour. (Currently have 30 hr/1 credit hour.) This does not change faculty load and is more reflective of the load and time commitment of both faculty and student. Faculty concerned the increase in credit hours would limit the semester in which they could enroll in the required upper level religion class. Reducing NUR302 The Nurse as a Teacher and NUR 465 The Nurse as a Counselor by one credit hour allows nursing students a choice of when to take Basic Issues of Faith and Life and still preserve their option of taking the popular nursing elective NUR 455 Synthesis of Concepts without overload. These changes will bring the nursing major total to 64 credit hours, making a total of 138 credits necessary to graduate with a BSN from Bethel College. It was moved that the Bethel College curriculum request for: Change in content requiring a change of clock-hours or credit hours in nursing courses be approved. Motion #8 Calhoun/Qamar Adopted UYVV.

U of KS.: University of Kansas represented by Dr. Wingate, requests a change in clinical credit hours to clock hour ratio. The following would be affected by this change.

1. NURS 341 Foundations and health promotion
2. NURS 366 Nursing of Adults
3. NURS 376 Nursing of Children
4. NURS 361 Psych/Mental Health Nursing

The total hours for Level I and II would decrease from 576 to 432. Level III courses will not be affected by the change. The new grand total would be 944 instead of 1088 which was the required clinical clock hour for the BSN program. It was moved that the University of Kansas, baccalaureate nursing program curriculum request for: Change in content requiring a change of clock-hours or credit hours in nursing courses, Change the ratio for clinical hours for Nurs 341, 366, 376 and 361 from 1:4 to 1:3 so the total clinical hours will be decreased as follows: Nurs 341 – 144, Nurs 366 – 96, Nurs 376 - 96 and Nurs 361 is 96 for a total of 432 from 576 be approved. Motion #9 Bartel/Calhoun Adopted. (1) Abstention Bonnel.

U of Kansas: Carol Elliott was present to represent KU Anesthesia School of nursing. It was moved that the University of Kansas, nurse anesthetist program curriculum request for: Change in content

requiring a change of clock-hours or credit hours in nursing courses, Delete NRS 810, Intro to Clinical Practice 8 Cr and NRS 812 Advanced Theory/Practice in Anesthesia II, Increase from 2 to 3 Cr NRS 834, Physical Assessment/Monitoring. Delete NRS 810 (8 credits) and add a new course, NRS 801 Introduction to Clinical Practice for 4 Cr. Add new course NRS 748/749 Theories: Bridge to Practice & Research 3 Cr. Split 811-815 into theory and clinical courses: NRS 811 Advanced theory 2 Cr; NRS 812 Advanced Theory 4 Cr, NRS 813 Advanced Theory 4Cr, NRS 814 Advanced theory 2 Cr, NRS 815 4 Cr. NRS 821 Practice I for 2 CR, 822 Practice II 4 Cr, NRS 823 Practice III for 4 Cr, NRS 824 Practice IV for 2 Cr, NRS 825 Practice V for 4 Cr. Add NRS 896 Field Project as alternative to thesis 899 and add 896 Filed Project to be approved. Motion #10 Qamar/Calhoun Adopted. (1 abstention Bonnel)

New Program Application

GCCC: Garden City Community College PN Program represented by Evelyn Bowman submitted an application for initial approval of a PN program. See committee packet. It was moved that the Garden City Community College application for approval of a practical nursing program is accepted. Motion #11 Bonnel/Hutchison Adopted. Survey visit to be scheduled in end of October or first of November for review at the December board meeting.

NEKTC: Northeast Kansas Technical College survey was reviewed. It was moved that the Survey Report of the Northeast Kansas Technical School is accepted pending the receipt of requirements addressing KAR 60-2-107 (a)(1) and KAR 60-2-102 (i)(3)(D). Motion #12 Bartel/Bonnel Adopted.

WTC: Wichita Technical College survey visit was reviewed. It was moved the Survey Report of the Wichita Technical College is accepted. Motion #13 Walsh/Calhoun Adopted.

Annual Rept: The summary of the annual reports was briefly reviewed. Recommendations were made. Final approval of annual reports will be made at the September meeting.
