Update on BOHA Regulations: Discussion of letter sent to the Kansas Board of Healing Arts from Board President, Judith Hiner outlining KSBN's position and concerns regarding the proposed physician supervision regulations 100-28-1(b), 100-28-4(j), 100-28-8(a) & (d), 100-28-6, and 100-28-7.

Terri Roberts stated that Community Mental Health Center Medical Directors had met with BOHA representative to discuss concerns.

Regulation revisions: Discussed change made by DOA with to 60-11-104, 104, 60-11-105, 60-11-107, and 60-11-105. Regulations are currently at the AG's office for review.

KAANP: Reviewed letters received from KAAPN; all issues have been address except for definitions that are not used in statute or regulation. Will verify with KAAPN if there are other issues to be addressed.

New Business: Discussion of the qualification regulations for Nurse Midwives and Nurse Anesthetist applicants from other states. Consensus that no changes to the qualification be made at this time. Requiring a masters degree for NMW may require a statute change to stay in compliance with 65-1130 (b).
