Minutes: The Practice/IV Therapy minutes of the March 29, 2011 meeting with revisions were reviewed. Susan White moved to approve the minutes with revisions and Debbie Hackler seconded. MSC.

Complaints/concerns: None

Unfinished Business Bill Anderson will provide an update after IV Therapy task group meeting in July. There are two new IV therapy providers. The group is still working toward changes necessary.

Diane will get more information from California on LMHT. The LMHT regulation status was discussed further. The proprietary group interested in reopening the Halstead facility is still interested in reviving an LMHT program. Discussion included: (1) the need for a statutory change to scope of practice (involves the KDHE credentialing process) to allow the practice described.

Diane will visit with credentialing at KDHE. (2) The need to develop contract for a test or change of statute to allow exam by other states and acceptance by KSBN after review so Diane will check on California availability and cost. (3) The need to review old curriculums of Kansas schools (now closed) to understand need for changes to make new anticipated scope. Diane will try to obtain new curriculum and Debbie Hackler will try to obtain Larned State Hospital's. (4) Diane will review LPN statutes and regulations for a way to allow additional education for LPNs to sharpen mental health knowledge. The LPN scope already includes this area so no changes to statutes or regulations would be needed.
