APRN Task Force No representative was in attendance from the APRN Task Force. The bill had an informational hearing and will need to be re-introduced next year.

RNA Statute The RNA Statute has passed through both Chambers and has gone to the Governor for signature. The Legislative Intent has not been received at KSBN yet.

The Dental Board had a hearing in February and passed a regulation that states on or after December 1, 2010, only a dentist, with a permit, or another person authorized by Kansas Law to administer sedative agent under supervision or a person authorized to administer the sedative without supervision, may administer a sedative agent designed to achieve anxiolysis, enteral conscious sedation, parenteral conscious sedation, deep sedation, or general anesthesia.
