Epidural Guidelines: Draft 1 of the Position Statement on Management of Analgesia by Catheter Techniques, submitted by Sandra Qamar and Patricia McAnany was reviewed. It will be revised and the second draft will be added to the December agenda.

New Business

ANA Position Statement: The position statement was discussed by the committee, and it will be put on the agenda for December.

K.A.R. 60-16-102: Diane Glynn discussed the corrections made to Draft 2 of the statute/regulation. The committee addressed clarity concerns of the IV Advisory Committee by adding, "not exceeding three inches in length in peripheral sites only" to a4 and adding b7 to read, "Changing dressings for central venous access devices."

Regulation Hearing Rpt.: The Regulation Hearing Report was in the onsite packet under miscellaneous and was reviewed by the committee.

KS Home Care Assn.: Linda Lubensky gave a presentation regarding Home Health policy/coding changes that went into effect on September 1, 2002.
