**Update on BOHA Regulations:** Meeting scheduled for October 2006. No further information available at this time.

**ARNP Regs from AG:** DEA number must be listed on all written prescriptions per Federal regulations. Pharmacies can not fill a script without DEA number written on script. They will be cited if reviewed by DEA. Reviewed all regulations, discussed the review of legislative intent and samples of language from seventeen other states that require written protocols. There are a great number of differences between those states as to their guidelines and many are more restrictive than our current language. Many also reference “medical aspects of care”. KSNA objects to use of “authorizing medical aspects of care” – suggested describe or outline.

Discussed changes in 60-11-103 to require a masters degree for nurse midwife category after July 1, 2009. Attorney General’s office responded that they think we have the statutory authority but 60-11-103 would need to be amended. Add #3 to 60-11-103 (d) “If none of the requirements in subsection (a) have been met before July 1, 2008, meet one of the requirements of subsection (a) of

this regulation and hold a masters degree in nursing” and add new (h) “Each applicant who completes and advanced registered nurse practitioner program after July 1, 2009, three college hours in advanced pathophysiology or its equivalent and three college hours in advanced health assessment or its equivalent”

Motion #1 – I move, to take regulations 60-11-101, 102, 103, 104, 104a, 105 and 107 forward to the Board for approval with specified changes in 60-11-103 by K. Gilpin 2<sup>nd</sup> B. Moffitt.

Reviewed the ARNP education regulation referred from the Education Committee. Amended 60-17-104 (d) (3) by inserting “coordinating” before clinical instruction and changing “role” to “category”; amended 60-17-105 (b) adding a new 8 “if completing an advanced registered nurse practitioner program after July 1, 2009, three college hours in advanced pathophysiology or its equivalent and three college hours in advanced health assessment or its equivalent for certification as an advanced registered nurse practitioner”; amended 60-17-105 (c) (2) by changing the date to July 1, 2009
