Call to Order: Meeting called to order by Jane Conroy.

Review of Onsite Packets: Regulations returned from AG's office (60-13-103, 60-13-104, 60-11-118) to be discussed under unfinished business, Letter received regarding radiology and letter received regarding FDA safety alerts

Unfinished Business:

Status of ARNP Regulations: Jane reported on the meeting held in Salina with representatives of four professional groups – Debbie Folkerts representing KSNA; Michelle Knowles, representing Great Plains, Lou Miller representing the Alliance and Doris Kimbrell representing the Regional Advanced Practice Group (CNS); no Nurse midwife representative attended. Jane brought suggestions to the meeting, they had a good discussion and a copy of the suggestions was prepared, distributed to the participants and is included in the packet with the header "Comments from Salina Meeting"

Jane indicated that 60-11-103 and 60-11-105 were sent back to the Committee by the Board; 60-11-101, 60-11-104 and 60-11-107 will be discussed by the board and as a courtesy, the recommended changes are in the packet as "August 2007 Draft" for review by the committee.

60-11-101	(a) added “advanced practice” and (d) changed definition of protocol to “authorization for collaborative practice”
60-11-104 & 60-11-107	(b) changed from “protocol” to “authorization for collaborative practice”
60-11-103	Reviewed the list of degrees conferred by nurse anesthesia and midwifery programs; KSNA objected to change in midwifery requirement based on 65-1130 – reviewed AG opinions from 10/28/1991 and 9/9/2006; Revised to make effective date for midwifery degree 1/1/2010 to coincide with ACNM changes Motion #2 to take KAR 60-11-103 forward by T. McKibben 2 nd J. McCart
60-11-105	Reviewed changes: addition of “through the life span”; change (b) to develop and manage a medical plan of care for each patient or client based on the authorization for collaborative practice; and (f) to “treat male clients for sexually transmitted disease and reproductive health needs” Discussion about whether using word “focusing” in (c) gives too much authority to NMW to practice in primary care setting; Jane indicated that these regs would be reviewed with the BOHA before they are taken forward Motion #3 That we hold 60-11-105 to ensure current language limits nurse midwives to gyn and pregnancy related care of women and not comprehensive primary care by A Siple 2 nd T McKibben
RNA Temp Permits	Discussed RNA temporary permits and test results with feedback from AANA; Tom indicated that there had been a recent split between AANA and the Council on Certification; There will be no changes in RNA temporary permit process at this time
60-13-103	Reviewed changes requested by the AG office
60-13-104	Reviewed changes requested by the AG office
60-11-118	AG indicated BON did not have statutory authority for a temporary permit for reinstatement;
FDA Safety Alert	provided as an FYI
Radiology information	Follow up for additional information and bring back to the December meeting

60-11-116 On legislative review schedule for last meeting; Patty was requested to review other regulations for reference to “certification” rather than certificate of qualification; List outlined in packet – error on last reg listed, should be 60-17-104; already in the process of changing 60-11-103

Recommend no changes; will make the change from “certification” to “certificate of qualification in this reg and other as the need to update other language in the reg occurs.

New Business:

Update on KSNA Meetings with KMS, KAFP, KOMA

Ellen Carson provided report; written copy attached to minutes

Jane asked if this meant that they do not have any language for 65-1130; Ellen indicated that KMS had offered some language but they did not like it and were still negotiating. When asked if they wanted to direct all aspects of ARNP practice or just the medical aspects, she responded that it was just the medical aspects but they continue to want “responsible physician” language”

Mary asked if they had any future meetings planned and if they would have anything to introduce this year; Ellen stated that was their goal. When they come up with some language, they will meet again
