Kansas Health Care Stabilization Fund:

Charles (Chip) Wheelen, HCSF Executive Director discussed the Kansas Care Stabilization Fund and the Enactment of House Bill 2516 (see attached handout). HB2516 adds nurse-midwives to the list of health care providers who are required to obtain professional liability insurance coverage and participate in the Kansas Health Care Stabilization Fund. This also means nurse-midwives will be eligible for insurance coverage via the Health Care Provider

Insurance Availability Plan. This will become effective January 1, 2015.

An affidavit can be obtained for those who have the intent of not rendering professional APRN services. This will need to be notarized and provided to the Kansas State Board of Nursing for placement in their nursing file.

APRN Inactive License Option:

Mary Blubaugh discussed the inactive license option for APRN's.
