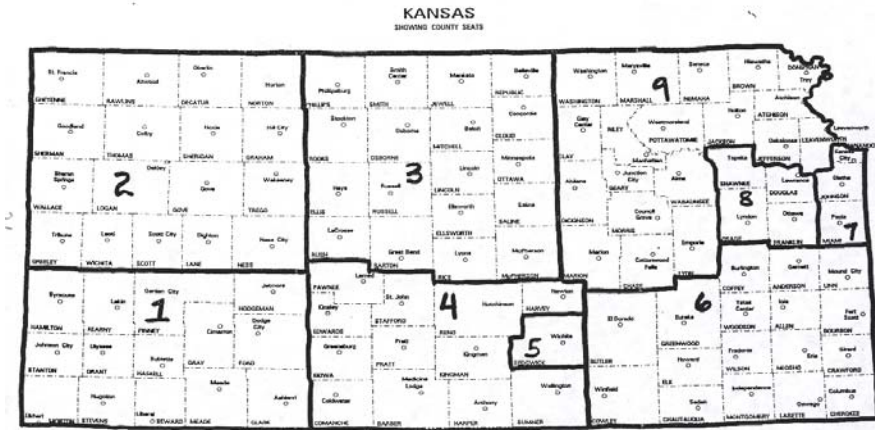
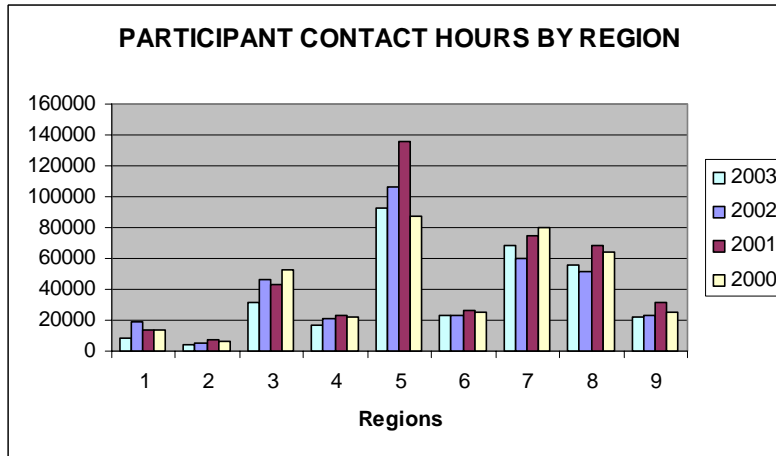


**E. CNE Contact Hours by Geographical Regions (Interactive)**

The state was divided into nine (9) geographic regions to identify and compare CNE contact hours provided within each region.



**F. Instructors of Continuing Nursing Education**

KSBN recommends that Long-Term CNE Providers design offerings so that at least 50% of the CNE offerings are presented by nurses. This expectation has been consistently exceeded. Contact hours presented by nurses for FY 2002 was 63% (14,210 hours).

**G. CNE Total Interactive Offerings, Participants, and Contact Hours**

- FY 2003: 4,368 Offerings – 57,018 participants – 22,636 contact hours.
- FY 2002: 4,569 Offerings – 60,874 participants -- 25,742 contact hours.
- FY 2001: 5,036 Offerings – 74,045 participants -- 27,637 contact hours.
- FY 2000: 4,428 Offerings – 69,681 participants -- 26,427 contact hours.
- FY 1999: 4,347 Offerings – 66,960 participants -- 23,620 contact hours.
- FY 1998: 5,320 Offerings – 89,035 participants -- 26,424 contact hours.

The average participants per offering was 14.7 in FY 2001 and has been 13 for the past 2 years. The average contact hours per offering remains 5.
