Licensure

RN

FY03 showed an increase in the total number of Registered Nurses licensed in the state of Kansas. Licenses issued by examination increased from 896 to 1124 which is 20% and the number of licenses issued by endorsement decreased from 1218 to 961 which is 21%. Of the 33,650 RN's 17% live out of state. (pg. 18)

LPN

FY03 showed an increase in the total number LPN's by 1%. Licenses issued by examination increased by 9% and the number of licenses issued by endorsement decreased by .02%. Of the 8350 LPN's 10% live out of state. (pg. 19)

LMHT

The total number of LMHT's showed a decrease by 19% from FY02 to FY03. Sixteen licenses were issued by examination. (pg. 20)

ARNP and RNA

There was an increase in the total numbers of ARNP's over FY2001 (pg. 40)

Due to conversion from PROMPT to KBON not all specialties converted.

There was a 4% increase in the total numbers of ARNP's over FY2002 (pg. 40)

Inactivated Licenses

Due to conversion from PROMPT to KBON inactive licenses were not available for FY00 so comparison to FY00 is not possible.

During FY01 3121 licensees went inactive. 1157 of the 3121 reside outside the state of Kansas.

During FY02 2945 licensees went inactive. 1251 of the 2945 reside outside the state of Kansas.

During FY03 3545 licensees went inactive. 1637 of the 3545 reside outside the state of Kansas.
