ORDER to SUSPEND LICENSE

Now on this 11th day of August, 2004 the petitioner's motion to suspend respondent's license to practice nursing in the State of Kansas comes on for hearing and the respondent appears in person, and the petitioner, the board of nursing, by and through disciplinary counsel for the board, Betty Wright, and after a full and fair hearing the hearing officer makes the following findings and orders:

1. The respondent signed a Consent Agreement to Reinstate with Limitations and Final Order on April 23, 2004. Respondent agreed to be compliant with KNAP. [REDACTED]

3. Continued nursing practice of respondent poses an immediate danger to the public health, safety or welfare.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. After hearing testimony of respondent, the hearing officer finds that violations of the nurse practice act have occurred.

[REDACTED] The respondent has violated:

K.S.A. 65-1120(a)(4), to be unable to practice with skill and safety due to current abuse of drugs or alcohol.

K.S.A. 65-1120(a)(6), unprofessional conduct by K.A.R. 60-3-110 (s) failing to

complete the requirements of the impaired provider program of the board.

6. The hearing officer finds that the license shall be suspended. **After three months (not before November 11, 2004)** the licensee can request a STAY of the suspension if KNAP has sent a letter to the Board counsel stating that he is safe to practice nursing. If the Board receives this information, the board counsel will prepare an Order to Stay the Suspension for signature of the hearing officer. The respondent can not practice nursing before that time.
7. Disciplinary counsel shall mail a copy of this order to respondent's last known address.
