

A public hearing will be conducted at 11:00 A.M Friday, May 21st, 2010 in Room 1051 of the Landon State Office Building, 900 SW Jackson, Topeka, to consider the revocation of one existing regulation relating to the advisory committee for IV therapy. This 60 day notice of the public hearing shall constitute a public comment period for the purpose of receiving written comment on the proposed revocation of one regulation. All interested parties may submit written comments prior to the hearing to the Executive Administrator of the Board of Nursing, Room 1051 Landon State Office Building, 900 S.W. Jackson, Topeka, Ks. 66612. All interested parties will be given a reasonable opportunity to present their views, orally or in writing, concerning the adoption of the proposed regulations during the hearing. Phone comments will be taken by calling 1-877-278-8686 (access code 161046) at 11:00 A.M. the day of the hearing. In order to give all persons the opportunity to present their views, it may be necessary to request each participant to limit any oral presentations to five minutes. A summary of the proposed regulations and the economic impact follows.

K.A.R. 60-16-105. Advisory Committee The proposed revocation of this regulation deletes the stand alone advisory committee for IV therapy. This committee has been incorporated into the practice committee for the board of nursing.
